

## Follow-Up to MCC Trade Compliance Clarification – Temporary EU Transaction Pause

Dear Valued MCC Customer,

We are writing to follow up on our prior communication titled **“MCC Trade Compliance Clarification”**, which outlined Micro Commercial Components Corp.’s (“MCC”) corporate structure, operational autonomy, and trade-compliance framework. As noted in that communication, MCC is a separately incorporated U.S. company that operates with independent management, governance, and compliance oversight. Those facts remain unchanged.

Following recent developments in the European Union and after consultation with both **EU and U.S. legal counsel**, MCC has decided, **out of an abundance of caution**, to pause shipments and commercial transactions with EU customers. This pause is a **precautionary compliance measure**, intended to allow MCC to fully evaluate the current regulatory landscape and to avoid any unintended consequences or unnecessary harm to our customers or partners.

MCC is fully and actively engaged with experienced legal counsel in both the United States and the European Union to address these matters promptly and transparently. In parallel, MCC is advancing corporate organizational and governance actions intended to further demonstrate and document MCC’s operational autonomy and independence, with the objective of supporting the **earliest possible resumption of compliant business transactions with EU customers**.

We expect to be able to provide additional updates on these efforts in the coming days.

We recognize the disruption this temporary measure may cause and sincerely appreciate your understanding and cooperation. MCC remains committed to transparency, lawful operations, and long-term partnerships with our EU customers.
